Established under the umbrella of Karate 1, and designed to complete Karate1 - Premier League and Karate1 - Series A, the Karate1 - Youth League aims at becoming a platform for the development of youngsters in their quest to progress in the sport.

The competition was devised to respond to the increasing interest of young competitors to have more options to compete at the highest level and it puts the focus on karatekas aged 12 to 17.

The number of competitors is open. All members of WKF are admitted to participate.

The WKF competition Rules in force will be applied.

8. RANKING

The applicable ranking will be the one updated on the day of the registration opening.
U-14 category does not earn ranking points.

9. ONLINE REGISTRATION & OFFICIAL ACCREDITATION

All registration in a Karate1 - Youth League event must be processed **ONLINE**. Onsite registrations will **NOT** be accepted. The registration will be validated once completed the online payment through the payment platform.

9.2 Entry Fee

The entry fees are € 40 per individual category entry.

9.3 Payment

Payments must be processed through the **ONLINE PAYMENT PLATFORM**. Onsite payments will **NOT** be accepted.

9.4 Official Accreditation

The official accreditation will take place on Thursday, 03/06/2021, from 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. at the “Spyros Kyprianou Athletic Center” in Limassol, Cyprus.

If changes are required during the official registration session, because of incorrect or missing registration data, a fee of € 20 is charged for each change.

At registration, accreditation cards will be issued with the participants main data, a photograph and information about registered categories. The accreditation card must be worn at all times during the event.

Only members of national federations recognized by WKF are admitted to participate, as per Karate1 - Youth League Organising Rules 2020 (YL OR Point 6 Registration).

All participants must submit an official document (passport or other valid ID card) for the WKF identification and validation at the accreditation session.

The accreditation of any competitor must be done by the athlete or the athlete’s coach, in person bringing the athlete passport or other valid ID at the accreditation session.

The competitor who has not collected, either personally or through his/her coach the accreditation during the official registration, will not be included in the draw.

The weighing will be carried out immediately after receiving the accreditation, those athletes who will not attend the weighing will not be included in the draw.

10. WKF ACCREDITED COACH PROGRAMME

According to the WKF Coach Educational Programme, the minimum certification required to take part in Karate1 – Youth League events is the “Accredited Coach” (level 1). To obtain such certification, coaches must pass the corresponding examination.

A WKF Programme for Coaches will be held in all Karate1 - Premier League events 2021 and WKF Accredited Coach Certification in all Karate1 - Youth League events 2021.

Only coaches in possession of the “WKF Accredited Coach” level have access to the “WKF Kumite or Kata certification”.

14.1 HQ Hotel

3. Accommodation is provided on a bed and breakfast basis.
4. The allocation of the rooms in the hotels will be on a priority basis, so delegations that have preference for particular rooms, should arrange their reservations the soonest.
5. Accommodation reservations should be accompanied with the reservation form.
6. Please note that travellers must enter the Republic of Cyprus through the official airports, which are the International Airports of Larnaca and Pafos.

PAYMENTS

1. Delegations are requested to book a precise reservation, specifying the number of rooms with names.
2. The Cyprus Karate Federation will send you the invoice from the selected hotel.

A deposit of 25% of the amount due is obligatory in order to obtain a fully confirmed reservation. This amount will be send direct to the account of the hotel which it will be informed at the issuing invoice. A full payment must be done 30th of April the latest.

For delegations that have paid the full amount and then cancelled within 20 days prior to the event, 25% of the reservation cost will be withheld as cancellation fee.

15. COVID-19 SANITARY PROTOCOL



CERTIFIED FACE MASKS

The use of Certified Masks of FFP2 type or equivalents (N95 (United States), KN95 (China), P2 (Australia/New Zealand), Korea 1st class (Korea), DS2 (Japan)) within the specifications for use is always mandatory in the venue, with the exceptions for athletes that are detailed herein.

Once an athlete enters the venue grounds the athletes must always wear Certified Masks except while warming up, training, and competing in the designated areas/tatamis, respectively. This also means the Certified Mask shall be worn in transit between the Warmup and Competition Areas.

 - I. The passenger would then be able to use the **unique number** in filling out his/her application for acquiring a **CyprusFlightPass**, by writing it down in the required space as special permit number.
 - II. The passenger must also send the **unique number** to the **Cyprus Karate Federation** at cypruskaratefederation@gmail.com, so they can facilitate the process with the ministries.

If health conditions permit it, there will be commercial stands selling official products, equipment and other merchandising with official branding.

20. MISCELLANEOUS

Alcohol

The legal drinking age in Cyprus is 17. Drivers should exercise due care over the amount of alcohol consumed. The legal limit in breath is 22 micrograms of alcohol per 100 millilitres of breath. The legal limit in blood is 50 milligrams of alcohol per 100 millilitres of blood.

Tobacco

If you are under 17 years old you are not entitled to a duty free allowance for tobacco.

Currency and Exchange

The currency of Cyprus is the Euro - €, which is divided into 100 cents.

Notes and coins currently in circulation are as follows:

Banknotes: €5, €10, €20, €50, €100, €200, €500.

There are coins in denominations of €2, €1, 50 cent, 20 cent, 10 cent, 5 cent, 2 cent and 1 cent. There are 100 cents to €1. For up to date exchange rates please visit to the website of the Central Bank of Cyprus, <https://www.centralbank.cy/>

Business Hours

Generally, shops will open between 07:00 - 21:00 on Monday - Saturday, but this can vary an hour or two either way, depending on the type of shop. On Sunday, opening times are later, typically around 11:00, and closing times vary from 14:00 - 22:00.

Some shops still observe a half-day closing on Wednesday and Saturday afternoons, and close on Sunday, although in most of the tourist areas of Cyprus, both shops and supermarkets stay open till late at night, and are also open on Sundays.

Electricity

In Cyprus the power plugs and sockets are of type G. The standard voltage is 240 V and the standard frequency is 50 Hz
