2. INTRODUCTION EKF SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

The EKF Senior Championships in Gaziantep 2022 will be held next 25-29 May 2022.

3. CITY / COUNTRY INFORMATION

3.1 About Gaziantep

Gaziantep, which has the oldest history in Turkey and is one of the cities still used as living space. The deep-rooted history of Gaziantep dates back to the Paleolithic Age, at the same time, many excavations dating from the Bronze Age are found here.

The city, which was under the rule of the Babylonian Empire in the first period of its establishment, later joined the territory of the Hittites, Egyptians, Meds, Assyrians and Persians and the Byzantine Empire respectively. After the victory of Alp Arslan in the Battle of Manzikert in 1071, Gaziantep, which passed into the city Seljuk rule, did not remain under the rule of Seljuk for a long time, but joined the Ayyubis, Dulkadiroğulları and Mamluk State.

The city, which was called Ayıntap at that time, passed under the rule of the Ottoman Empire in 1516 after the victory of Yavuz Sultan Selim in the Battle of Mercidabık.

3.2 Places to see in Gaziantep

Şahinbey War Museum

This museum is one of the first places visited by everyone who comes to Gaziantep. Standing out with its food culture, Antep is also known for its struggle in the War of Independence. Not only those experienced during the war period, but also the socio-economic change experienced by the people are described in detail. You should definitely visit this museum!

Coppersmith Bazaar

Would it be possible to go to Gaziantep and stop by Bakırcılar Bazaar? In the place, which is the most famous bazaar of Gaziantep, it is possible to see the craftsmen who process copper in every corner. You can buy many souvenirs from this market.



Zincirli Bedesten Bazaar

Another place you should see in Gaziantep, famous for its bazaars, is Zincirli Bedesten Bazaar. Spices and souvenirs are sold in the bazaar built by Hüseyin Pasha, Darendeli in the 17th century.

Customs Inn

There are many shops and workshops in Customs Inn, which is a historical inn where you can find all the crafts that are still in Gaziantep. If there is a handicraft you are curious about, you can go here and watch their works. You can also drink Turkish coffee at the inn, where two different coffees are cooked in one cup. We have no doubt that you will go here and have a good time.

Gaziantep Castle

It came to a very famous building in the center of Gaziantep: Gaziantep Castle. The building, which was used to observe the city in the Roman period, is open to visitors as a museum today.

Naib Turkish Bath

The Naib Bath, which Evliya Çelebi talked about when visiting the city, is one of the important structures of Gaziantep. The bath, built in 1640, has been restored and ready for visitors.

Zeugma Mosaic Museum

Zeugma Mosaic Museum, which is visited by many visitors from the world, is one of the most famous places in Gaziantep. The second largest mosaic museum in the world, the museum exhibits over 2000 mosaics. If you visit Gaziantep, you should see this museum.

Zeugma Ancient City

Ancient City BC The ancient city, which was founded by Alexander the Great in 300 under the name "Selevkia Euphrates", took this name during the Roman Empire. If you want to witness a long history, you should visit the Ancient City of Zeugma.







Only those athletes having their documents uploaded **until the end of registration** may be moved from the "waiting list" to the actual list of registered athletes for the event.

All documents MUST be attached in English for ALL registered athletes. All MDFs must be completed by a registered Medical Doctor, M.D.

PARA-KARATE ATHLETES PER CATEGORY

Every nation has the opportunity to register three (3) Para-Athletes per sport class. In total, 24 athletes can be called by each nation.

CLASSIFICATION SESSION

Classification in Para-Karate consists in an extra point compensation depending on the influence of the particular impairment when performing the Kata. Detailed information can be found in the Para-Karate regulations: https://www.wkf.net/sport-parakarate

Please, check the Para-karate Classification rules https://www.wkf.net/pdf/ParaKarate_Classification_Rules.pdf or Para- Karate information sheet https://www.wkf.net/pdf/ParaKarate_Info%20Sheet.pdf to ensure that the athlete presents at least one of the mentioned eligible impairments which have to be proven by the MDF.

Registered Para-Karate athletes must present themselves for a mandatory onsite Classification Session performed by qualified personnel before the championships. The



Classification Session will therefore be performed on Thursday 20th May - HQ Hotel 10:00 - 18:00 Room KINALIADA

A timetable for the classification session will be published after the registration online.

Attendance to the Classification Session is obligatory, without a participation in such event it is not possible to take part in the championships.

Following documents have to be provided at the classification session:

- Accreditation of the athlete
- Passport of the athlete
- Original MDF as provided prior with the registration
- Diagnostic Report as described in the MDF for Intellectual Impairments as provided with the registration

Coaches and personal assistants

Maximum of three coaches can be registered for Para-Karate per Nation.

Every Para-Karate athlete can be accompanied by a personal assistant during their performance in the field of play.

Coach and assistants accompanying Para-Karate athletes MUST register together with their delegation at the onsite registration session.

All athletes must use the same sportswear and equipment for classification as they use during competitions.

Concerning athletes with visual impairments, no extra testing will be performed during the classification session. Nevertheless, the athletes have to show up to the classification with the documents and equipment mentioned above. Extra points will be given based on the Medical Diagnostic Form.

ANTI-DOPING

In compliance with WKF Anti-Doping Rules and WADA, Para-Karate athletes will be subject to any eventual testing. In any Para-Karate athlete would need a Therapeutic Use Exemptions (TUE), please contact your National Anti-Doping Organization for further details and recognition. The duly recognized TUE at national level will then have to be duly communicated to the WKF.



CERTIFIED FACE MASKS

The use of Certified Masks of FFP2 type or equivalents (N95 (United States), KN95 (China), P2 (Australia/New Zealand), Korea 1st class (Korea), DS2 (Japan)) within the specifications for use is always mandatory in the venue, with the exceptions for athletes that are detailed herein.

Once an athlete enters the venue grounds the athletes must always wear Certified Masks except while warming up, training, and competing in the designated areas/tatamis, respectively. This also means the Certified Mask shall be worn in transit between the Warmup and Competition Areas.


